Some recent successes have been:

In 2016, the University of SC and IBM celebrated the opening of the 25 million dollar Center for Applied Innovation, a fiberglass company from China opened in Pineview Industrial Park, and a local IT company, T Cube Solutions, moved to Bull Street.

There is much more interest in the downtown area and the City is working to make Columbia a "livable community" where you can live, work and play. The Bull Street development should expand this idea and a "loft hotel" also opened on the corner of Lincoln and Lady.
