Our neighborhood approved working on getting certified as a Wildlife Habitat some time ago and we are now moving ahead with this project. Certification involves a lot of fun projects, so keep your ears and eyes open for them in the coming months. Valerie Marcil and Pat Mason will co-chair this project. One of the first things we need to do is get 20-40 individual yards certified as Wildlife Habitats through the South Carolina Wildlife Federation (and the National Wildlife Federation). Hey Neighbors! In keeping with our stated theme, "Taking Pride", the PDF link below is a reminder that the Sherwood Forest Neighborhood Association voted unanimously (many years ago) to adopt and become

protected by the regulations as described. We are privileged to be one of very few Columbia neighborhoods certified by this Character Protection code. Should you or your general contractor have plans for major architectural design changes and or demolition, this is a document you will want to review carefully to be in full compliance.




Neighborhood News:

Sherwood Forest Wins a Treasured Tree Award! Recognizing and honoring keystone trees across Columbia has been a welcome tradition for many years.


